As the Head Instructor (H.I.) at Wizville Language Institute I am in charge of ensuring the smoothing running and implementation of the curriculum set up by the school for all the foreign staff members to be executed within their classes throughout the year. There are currently 16 foreign staff members, all of which report directly to me on a daily bases. During my time at Wizville, as the H.I. I have been overseeing the planning, implementation and development of lesson plans and test procedures for the elementary classes as well as kindergarten classes. I report directly to the director of the school and take part in weekly meetings with her, where we discuss matters pertaining to the staff and school. I hold weekly meetings with the foreign staff where I relay messages from the director and I also use this time as an open free communication period where I encourage teachers to bring their concerns directly to me. During my time as the H.I. I have created a manual for the educators to use to help them with the daily duties and troubles they may encounter. I also conduct interviews and screenings of educators looking for the opportunity to work at the school. I am currently in charge of two 7.3 classes where I teach a combined 23 classes per week. These classes include Language Art, Circle Time, Power Reading, just to name a few.
